## Key Performance Areas

- Operate and monitor boiler systems, ensuring all control instruments, valves, gauges, and pumps are functioning correctly.
- Conduct regular inspections of pipes, vessels, cylinders, and auxiliary equipment.
- Monitor and control fluid levels (diesel, water, chemicals) to maintain safe and efficient operation.
- Perform maintenance during breakdowns, planned maintenance, and as instructed by the Technical Manager.
- Ensure standby equipment is operational at all times.
- Maintain accurate records, including daily checklists and job card sign-offs.
- Adhere to all company policies, including maintenance, OSHE, and general operational procedures.
- Maintain housekeeping standards in the boiler house, air receiver unit, and effluent plant.
- Report deviations, unsafe conditions, and initiate job cards when required.
- Participate in SHEQ activities, including audits, incident reporting, and compliance with legal requirements.
- Manage own performance and support training, guidance, and supervision of staff where required.
- Perform lawful and operationally required tasks as instructed, ensuring compliance with HR policies and procedures.
